Honey Bees

- * Live in large colonies of up to 60,000 bees
 - * Do not hibernate
 - * Make honey
- * Worker bees care for the larvae
- * Queen bee doesn't perform tasks of workers
- * Workers collect pollen in pollen baskets.
- * Create homes from wax made from their bodies

- * Collect pollen and nectar
- * Bodies parts (not all parts): Head, Thorax, Abdomen, Proboscis, Stinger, Antenae, Eyes (5!)

Native Bees

- * Can live socially in smaller colonies (bumble bees) or live alone (solitary bees).
- * Hibernate
- * Do not make honey
- * Females perform both queen and worker jobs
- * Don't always have a pollen basket (collect on furry stomachs)
- * Find homes
